CONTEST NOTES: Another first contest of the summer surf series, and it is our 24th year of running contests and seeing some great times with all of you. This series started out great too. The weather was great and the conditions were good. The competitor had great attitudes and performances.

BOY'S DIVISION: It was a surprisingly low turn out for this first contest, but those who did compete had a great time. The finals was competitive as the contestants had to battle late afternoon conditions and gain some good rides. Coming out in first was **Zach Morabito** with 30.5 points, scoring 6's. Next with 28.5 was **Jayson Payne** also having some good rides. Taking third just behind with 27.5 was **Jachin Hamborg** who came in third, while **Matt Porteous** took fourth with 25 points, also having a great first round heat as well. Fifth place with 22.5 was **Wesley Krautkramer** and taking home sixth with 12 points was **Cory Fults**. It was a good day, hope to see more of you next month.

Other results: Equal sevenths went to **Tyler Porteous** and **Carson Gibbs** while ninth went to **Nick Campbell**.

JUNIOR'S DIVISION: It was a very close final with first and second decided by a half point scoring very good on their waves. Scoring 34 points and taking first was **Bobby Okvist**, taking first and second in his other heats. Also having a perfect day leading in to the final was **Vance Smith** who scored 33.5, taking second. Third went to **Erik Heimstaedt** who scored 27 points, while **Cole Devine** was just a point back scoring 26 and taking fourth. **Mike Anderson** earned fifth with 24.5 with a great showing through the day. Sixth place, scoring 24 points was **Mitchell Daub**, who was consistent all day long.

Other results: Equal sevenths went to **Derek Bostelman** and **Matt McElroy** (who both had a first and second going into the finals) while equal ninths went to **Kyle Johnson** and **Cheyne Shoffner**.

MEN'S DIVISION: Wow, what a way to start the season - first of all with a strong showing in numbers and then the competition in the final. It's was so strong that all the finalist scored in the thirties. Scoring 39 in the final and perfect all day

was **Vance Smith**, scoring 7's in the final, and after he took second in the Junior's. Close behind was **Keetin Devine** and **Jarred Williams**, they both tied for points with 37, after the count back, Keetin took second



cleanly on the count back (21 to 20) by scoring a 7.5 on one of his waves. Jarred secured third place. Scoring 33 points, was **Andrew Donahue** who was very consistent all day long, taking fourth place. Close behind him with 32 points was **Parker McMullin**, taking fifth place. **Steve Sendejas** took sixth, scoring 31 points, who placed second and first in his other heats.

Other results: Seventh place went to **Cody Bertrand** while eighth place went to **Darren Limbach** and ninth place went to **Chucky Rigano**.

WOMEN'S DIVISION: A lite showing in this first contest but we anticipate more in July. Taking first with 20.5 in her first CCSA summer contest was **Brooke Diagneault**, as second scoring 15.5 was **Krystle Melton**. Taking third with 12 points was **Natalie Schutt** who also surfed her first summer contest. Earning fourth place, another first timer, was **Robin Sweeney**, who scored 10 points, while **Sheila Huber** took fifth with 9.5 points.

LONG BOARD DIVISION: It was a battle for first place. Both **Mick Rodger** and **Terry Carmadella** scored 30 points, then came the count back and both seemed to score 18 then on the third wave count Mick edged Terry 11 to 8.5 and securing first place as Terry took second. Just a point and a half back with 28.5 was **Patrick Schlick**, who scored some 6's in the finals. **Troy Bertrand** had a good day scoring 26 points and took fourth place. Fifth went to **Bryan Stanley** as he scored 23.5 points, while **Tony Barona** took sixth in the finals with 20.5 points.

Other results: Equal sevenths went to **Cory Strand** and **Kenny Wright** while ninth went to **Jeff Woodcock**.
