Great Surf Dominates Finals with E. Heimstaedt, M. Payne, B. Davis, S. Huber & M. Rodgers taking First in an AA Event

Last contest we had great weather, really good surf and as always the competition was exciting.

BOY'S DIVISION: It was a great final as the boys went wave to wave scoring high and keeping it close by scoring 7.5's and 7's. Coming out on top with 40 points was **Blake Davis**, taking second close behind was **Jachin Hamborg** with 39.5 points staying on top in the overall standings. That was really close. Third place with 32 points was **Charlie Hawthorne**, who also had a few good waves too. Scoring 29 points and taking fourth was **Craig Bartlett**, while fifth place went to **Jayson Payne** with 24.5, in second in the overall stabdings. Sixth place with 22.5 point was **Matt Porteous** who is now in third place in the overall.

Other results: Equal sevenths went to **Tyler Baker** and **Luke Barrett** while equal ninths went to **Joey Mena** and **Dusty Mouridian**.

JUNIOR'S DIVISION: The juniors had some great surf and rides for thier final too. **Matt Payne** had some great waves scoring 7.5 and 7 on his waves totaling 42 points and taking first place. In second place with 39 points was **Vance Smith**, who was able to stay on top in the overall. Third place went to **Cole Devine** with 35.5 which moved him into second overall. Fourth place just behind with 34.5 points was **Erik Heimstaedt** (he did well in the men's. Fifth place with 31 points was **Cornec Hugo** (who came all the way from France to surf with us (maybe not, but it sounds good). Taking sixth place was **Zach Porteous** with 29.5 who is now in fourth in the overall.

Other results: Equal sevenths went to **Brian Cicerone** and **Jeremy Jennings** while equal ninths went to **Nick Boyd** and **Ruben Munoz**.

MEN'S DIVISION: Getting into the finals for all of the surfers in the men's was tough, after getting in it seemed

even tougher for all first place finishers had a countback to deemine determine the winner, with both **Erik Heimstaedt** and **Vance Smith** scoring 39 points with 7.5's and 7's. Then in the count

READ: [1 Corinthians 9:24-27](#)

It's as true in life as in running: Only the determined achieve their goals. Olympic medals don't go to overweight businessmen who occasionally puff around the track for exercise.

Eric Liddell, in the film *Chariots of Fire*, illustrates this principle. Just before the first turn in a 400-meter race, Eric was shoved off balance, and he stumbled onto the infield grass. When he looked up, he saw the others pulling away. With a look of intense determination, Eric jumped up. With his head cocked back and his arms flailing, he rushed ahead. He was determined not only to catch up with the pack but to win the race. And he did!

This was the kind of fervor that the apostle Paul brought to his ministry. In 1 Corinthians 9:24 he said, "Do you not



know that those who run in a race all run, but one receives the prize? Run in such a way that you may obtain it." Paul saw himself as being like an Olympic athlete who is competing for a gold medal, straining every muscle in his body to get to the finish line. And what is the prize? It's not a temporary reward but "an imperishable crown" (v.25).

Victory is possible for every Christian. So let's run as though we want to win! —HWR
