# Summer Heats up as Keetin Devine, Jeremy Jennings, Blake Davis, Wendy Black and Mike Arroyo all take First

**CONTEST NOTES:** Next Contest will be at Goldenwest St. Last contest we had great weather, good surf and a few new contestants making their way into the finals, it truly was an exciting day.

**BOY'S DIVISION:** It was a repeat day for **Blake Davis**, as he took first place as he did last contest. This heat was close as he scored the same as **Fritz Howzer** 26.5 points, but on the count back Blake edged out Fritz 14.5 to 14, giving Fritz second place. Third place with 24 points was **Jachin Hamborg**, who was able to keep himself in the top spot in the overall. Fourth place went to **Charlie Hawthorne** scoring 22.5 and sitting in the sixth overall. Fifth place went to **Jayson Payne** (again took fifth last month too) he had 18 points and remains in second in the overall standings. Sixth place went to **Luke Barrett** who is in eighth overall, but in striking distance of the top six.

**Other results:** Equal sevenths went to **Wesley Krautkammer** and **Jake Van Herk** while equal ninths went to **Brook Westervelt** and **Andrew Wilson**.

**JUNIOR'S DIVISION:** The final heat was hard fought and fun while **Jeremy Jennings** took first with 27.5 and moved him into third overall. Close behind with 26 points in second was **Cole Devine** who moved into first in the overall. Third place went to **Matt Payne** with 25 points which moved him into fifth overall. Fourth place went to **Fritz Howzer** just behind with 24.5 points. **Erik Heimstaedt** took fifth place with 24 points and is in second overall. Taking sixth place with 18 points was **Tommy Lobasso**.

**Other results:** Equal sevenths went to **Nick Boyd** (now in seventh overall) and **Zach Porteous** (remains in fifth overall) while equal ninths went to **Blake Bowie** and **Andrew Thomason**.

**MEN'S DIVISION:** Getting the results for first place was a lot of work, needing to count back to the very end. Both

contestants scored 35 points, both first count back was the same, even the next count back tied. It took the next few waves to determine the first place finisher who was **Keetin Devine** moving him into the overall lead. Second place went to **Matt Payne** helping himself into second overall. Third place with 28.5 was **Charles Rigano** which moved him also up to third place in the overall too. Taking fourth with 26.5 was **Chad Masri** who moved up nicely from 19th to 9th and is in striking distance of the top six. **Erik Heimstaedt** scored 26 earning fifth place and now in six overall. **Parker McMullin** scored 21 points taking sixth and moved up another spot in the overall.

It was a close seesaw battle but coming out on top with 34.5 was **Mike Arroyo** scoring on 6's and 7's. Taking second with 32.5 and remaining in first in the overall, was **Mick Rodgers**. 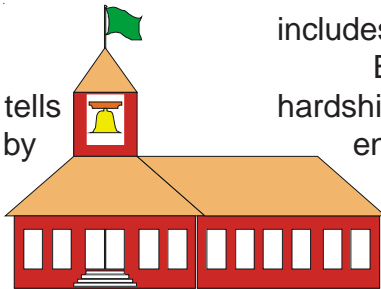
## God's Training School

READ: [1 Corinthians 9:24-27](#)

Low Wallace's book *Ben-Hur* tells the story of a Jewish aristocrat betrayed by his best friend and condemned to serve as a galley slave in the Roman navy. On a forced march to the ship, Judah Ben-Hur meets Jesus of Nazareth, whose compassion fills him with hope. Eventually, Ben-Hur saves the Roman commander during battle. In gratitude, the commander adopts Ben-Hur as his son, instantly elevating him from slave to heir.

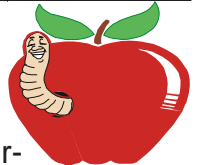
That's what happens to us when God adopts us into His family. But great privilege brings great responsibility. Paul said that we become "heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him" (Rom. 8:17). The gospel does not say, "Come to Jesus and live happily ever after." God's syllabus for His children's education



includes training through hardships.

Ben-Hur's years of enduring hardship as a Roman slave strengthened him and increased his endurance. He eventually defeated his "friend-turned-enemy" in a chariot race.
