# Overall is Set, October Invitational in Sight... Devine, Payne, Farris, McWilliams & Feolo take First in the Final

**CONTEST NOTES:** Next Contest will be South Side H.B. Pier. Everyone who has surfed in a 2008 Summer contest is invited to surf in this contest. (Top six get a paid entry). Sign up asap to secure a spot.

**BOY'S DIVISION:** There was very little movement in the overall, but the surfing was moving all day long. Reaching the finals with a perfect day was **Blake Davis**, but he was absent from the final along with **Matt Porteous** giving them both equal fifths. Sad, because this final was good with **Jachin Hamborg** and newcomer **Aryn Farris** surfing it out. Wave by wave the went back and forth, went the horn blew **Aryn** edged **Jachin** by a half a point, 25 to 24.5. The strong finished kept **Jachin** in first in the overall. Third place went to **Daniel Hughes** with 19.5 (also first time CCSA). Fourth place with 14.5 went to **Jayson Payne** who stayed in second in the overall.

**Other results:** Equal sevenths went to **Wes Krautkrammer**, who finished in fifth overall and **Austin Stephens** while equal ninths went to **Christian Comet** and **Dustin Mouradian**, who finished seventh in the overall.

**JUNIOR'S DIVISION:** Going into the final **Matt Payne** was perfect, then it seemed it turn it up even more scoring a blistering 47.5 points with a 9 and 7.5 waves. The win moved him into third for the overall. Taking second with 38 points was **Jeremy Jennings** scoring a 7 on one of his waves. The points moved him into second in the overall. Third place went to **Cole devine** who scored 34 with a 6.5 wave, looking only to finish in the final to securing the top spot in the overall standings. **Luke Mabry** scored 26.5 and finished fourth (his first time CCSA). Fifth place went to **Kent Williams** with 22.5, in the top ten in the overall, while sixth place with 20 points went to **Austin Palmore**.

**Other results:** Equal sevenths went to **Cheyne Shoffner** (who moved into the desired sixth in the overall) and **Kyle Johnson** (finished in eighth overall) while equal ninths went to **Adam Farris** and **Andrew Thomason**.

**MEN'S DIVISION:** Keeping his distance from the rest of the field, **Keetin Devine** had as near perfect day, getting first in all but one heat (a second), which gave him first in the overall, scoring 41.5. Second place went to **David O'Toole** surfing his first CCSA, scoring 38 points. Third went to **Richard Payne** with 36.5 and moved him into seventh overall. Taking fourth with 32.5 was **Ryan McAfee** who surfed his first CCSA this year. **Andrew Donahue** scored 32 earning fifth place and moved from 18th into ninth in the overall. **Matt Payne** only needing to reach the finals to secure second overall, scored 13.5 taking sixth and doing just that.

**Other results:** Equal seventh places went to **Jordan Black** (12th overall) and **Todd Hutton** while equal ninths went to **Anthony Feolo** (who moved up to fifth in the overall) and **Peter Kelly Jr.**

**WOMEN'S DIVISION:** **Keeley McWilliam** took first in her first CCSA and made the top six in the process. **Krystle Melton** finished second, and secured first place in the overall. Taking third was **Brooke Daignault** who finished in third in the overall, while fourth place went to **Ali Hayes**, again (she took fourth last contest) she finished in fifth overall. **Wendy Black** finished fifth and moved into fourth in the overall. **Sheila Huber**, who took sixth, finished strong in second place for the overall standings.

**LONG BOARD DIVISION:** Surfing to first with 35 points was **Anthony Feolo** moving him into third. Taking second with 34 and taking first in the overall, was **Patrick Schlick**. Third place went to **Edgar Apodaca** with 31 points, in the top ten. **Troy Bertrand** had 27 points getting fourth and moved up a spot to second overall. **Brennan Rhoades** surfed to fifth place with 26.5 points moving him from 23rd to 11th place. **Tony Barona** took sixth place with 24 and gave him second in the overall points standings.

**Other results:** Seventh went to **David Stone** (first CCSA contest) while eight went to **Michael Barrett** who went into the top ten in the overall.
